The following are some of the school rules/procedures for building good character in pupils.


FOR PARENT/GUARDIAN & PUPIL:

- 1. Application forms are sold at a cost of Tsh.20,000/=
- 2. Any money paid to the accountant will not be refunded to the client. (Non-refundable)
- 3. Every child must have done at least the payments of the first term (1st instalment) of the school fees if not all, before reporting at school.
- 4. All new comers must submit their transfer forms to the head teacher before reporting to school
- 5. For children who are using school bus services, they must have paid for the service before reporting at school.
- 6. A child will be accepted at this school if the parent agrees to all instructions in this form.
- 7. For children with health problems, they must submit their medical / health forms from the recognizable hospital to the head teacher before reporting at school.
- 8. A child will be accepted at this school if they do not have contagious diseases, and if the child has any health issues, the parent must inform the school administration.
- 9. Pupils are not allowed to braid or burn hair, grow dreadlocks or nails, wear makeup of any kind, wear headscarves, wear hijab, wear jeans, necklaces, bangles, earrings, tight clothes, and other similar items.
- 10. All school uniforms are sold at school, no uniform shall be allowed made else apart from being provided at school.
- 11. Every child must be well-dressed in school uniform during school hours.
- 12. Pupils must speak English at all times, except during Swahili lessons.
- 13. Field Trips/Picknicks and Study Tours are payable separately from school fees, payments for study tours are suggested according to the place which shall be visited.
